Please note the following changes to the subject RFQ before submitting your responses. Note the changes below in red:

1. Initial Proposal Due Date: Wednesday, January 24, 2018, 3:00 p.m.

The Proposal Due Date has been changed to: **Monday, January 29, 2018, 3:00 p.m.**

2. Initial RFQ language:

Section IV.A. Minimum Qualifications: “2. If proposing to provide Stabilization Units, a minimum of two (2) years of experience providing shelter, transitional housing, or permanent housing to homeless and formerly homeless families. Agencies must also have a history of providing clinical supervision and documenting service types.”

It has been changed to:

“2. If proposing to provide Stabilization Units, a minimum of two (2) years of experience providing shelter, transitional housing, or permanent housing to homeless and formerly homeless families. Agencies must also have a history of providing clinical supervision and documenting service types. **If the provider is only seeking site control and stabilization units, clinical experience is not required.**”

3. Initial RFQ language:

Section IV.A. Minimum Qualifications: “**Please note:** Agencies submitting qualifications that have previously been contracted by the City and County of San Francisco and/ or Federal agencies to provide goods and/or services must demonstrate compliance with performance/monitoring requirements in previous grants/contracts in order to be considered responsive to this RFQ.

**Documented failure to correct performance/monitoring deficiencies identified in past City and County grants/contracts may result in Agency disqualification to participate in this RFQ.”**

It has been changed to:

**This section has been entirely removed from the RFQ.**

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
