#### **Current Year HSH Budget Issues**

- Sunset of one-time funds (Whole Person Care and other state funds, philanthropic funds)
- Funding gaps for legacy contracts
- ► COVID-19 Response and FEMA extension required monthly budget rebalancing
- Identifying Funds for Immediate Needs (Expansion of Non-Congregate Shelter)



#### **City Fiscal Outlook**

- Financial forecast projects a \$108.1 million surplus over the upcoming two-year budget cycle. Key Drivers:
  - Overall growth in General Fund revenue
  - Significant ongoing savings in retirement due to record returns
  - Constrained ongoing costs
- Continued projected structural deficit in future years but with a significant reduction
- **→**Ongoing Risks:
  - COVID-19 variants and public health response
  - Pace of recovery and continued impact on local economy



## **Mayor's Budget Instructions**

- No mandatory reductions, but no increase to General Fund support
- Prioritize restoring San Francisco's vibrancy, recovery, accountability, and equity
- ►Get "back to basics" and improve core service delivery within existing budget levels

#### **2022 Budget Timeline**

- February 22: Proposed HSH budget submitted to Mayor's Office
- March-May: Mayor's Office budget development
- June 1: Mayor releases proposed FY 2022-23—FY 2023-24 Budget
- **June**: Board of Supervisors budget hearings and revisions
- **July**: Board of Supervisors adopts final FY 2022-23—FY 2023-24 Budget
