- The California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) administers the CESH Program with funding received from the Building Homes and Jobs Act Trust Fund (SB 2, Chapter 364, Statutes of 2017)
- Eligible activities include: housing relocation and stabilization services (including rental assistance), operating subsidies for permanent housing, flexible housing subsidy funds, operating support for emergency housing interventions, and systems support for homelessness services and housing delivery systems.
- For CESH 2018, San Francisco received \$1.6 M out of the total pool of \$53 M.
- For CESH 2019, San Francisco will receive \$900K out of the total pool of \$27 M.
