



Coordinated Entry for Youth Key Provider Update



Eligibility

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- An unaccompanied person over 17, or legally emancipated, and under the age of 25 when entering services
- Must have stayed in San Francisco one out of the last seven nights
- Meet SF Definition of Homelessness



San Francisco Definition of Homelessness

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- Category 1 – Literal Homelessness
- Category 2 – Imminent Risk
- Category 4 – Fleeing Violence



TAY Housing Options

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- Permanent Supportive Housing
- Care not Cash Housing
- Rising Up Rapid Rehousing



Permanent Supportive Housing

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- TAY eligible for both Youth and Adult PSH
- Age: 18+ or emancipated minors
- Rent: 30% of gross income
- Unit Type: SROs and Studios throughout SF
- Eligibility: Enrolled in CE and Priority Status



Care not Cash

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- Age: 18+ or emancipated minors
- Rent: \$318 or \$503
- Unit Type: SRO
- Eligibility: Enrolled in CE, Priority Status II AND CAAP Active



Rising Up

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- Age: Clients enrolled in CE before 25th birthday eligible for RU until their 27th birthday or emancipated minors
- Rent: Client decides portion of income dedicated to rent. Receive up to a 36 month subsidy
- Unit type: Studios, 1-2 bedrooms (with roommate/s)
- Eligibility Requirements: Enrolled in CE, RU Priority Status



Coordinated Entry Blitz Goals

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- Open up 6 Access Points for Youth
- Problem Solve and assess 300 youth experiencing homelessness
- Problem Solve and assess 60 LGBT youth and 25 TGNC youth

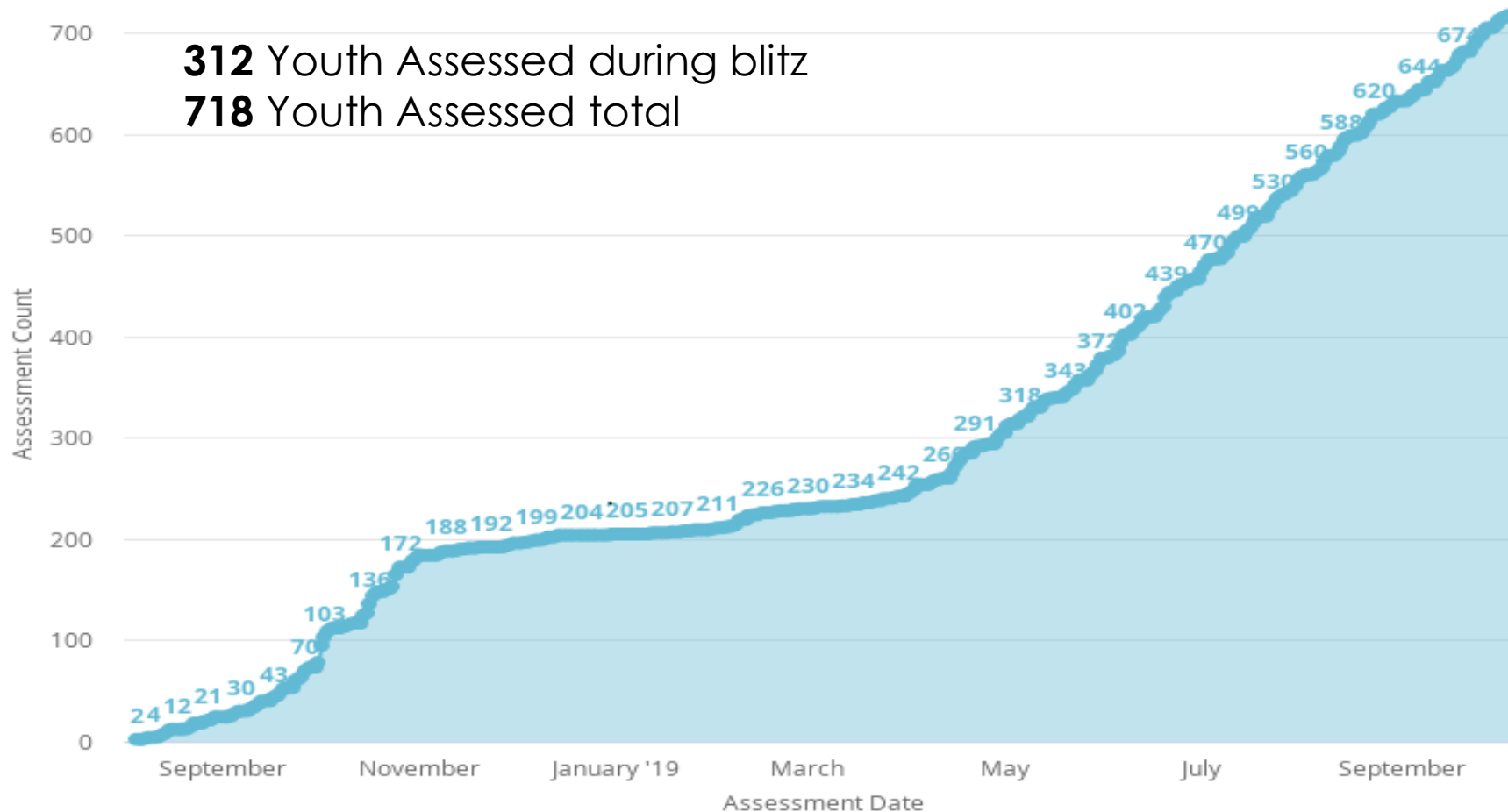

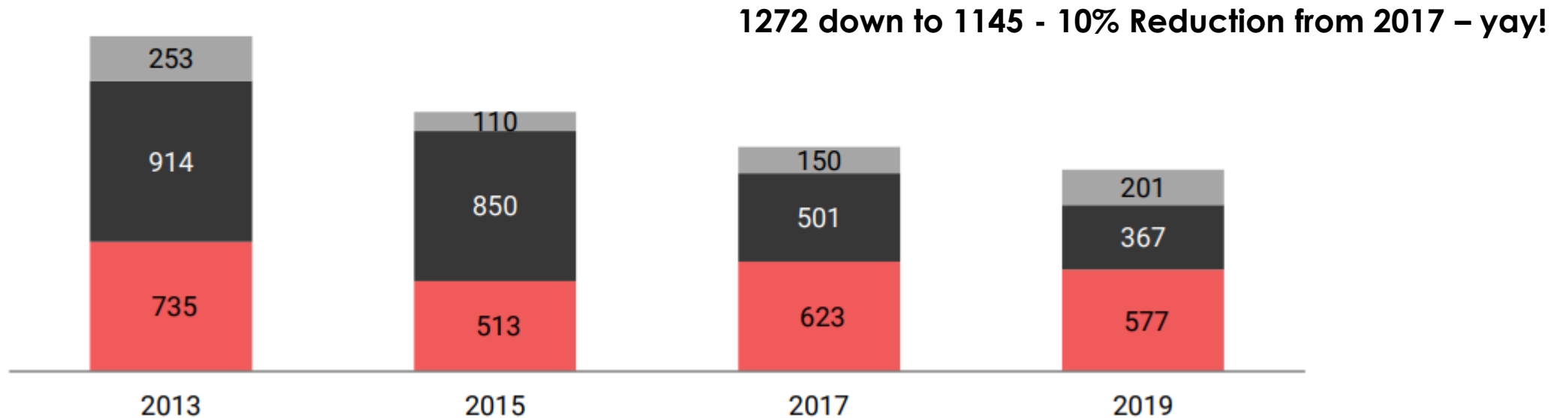




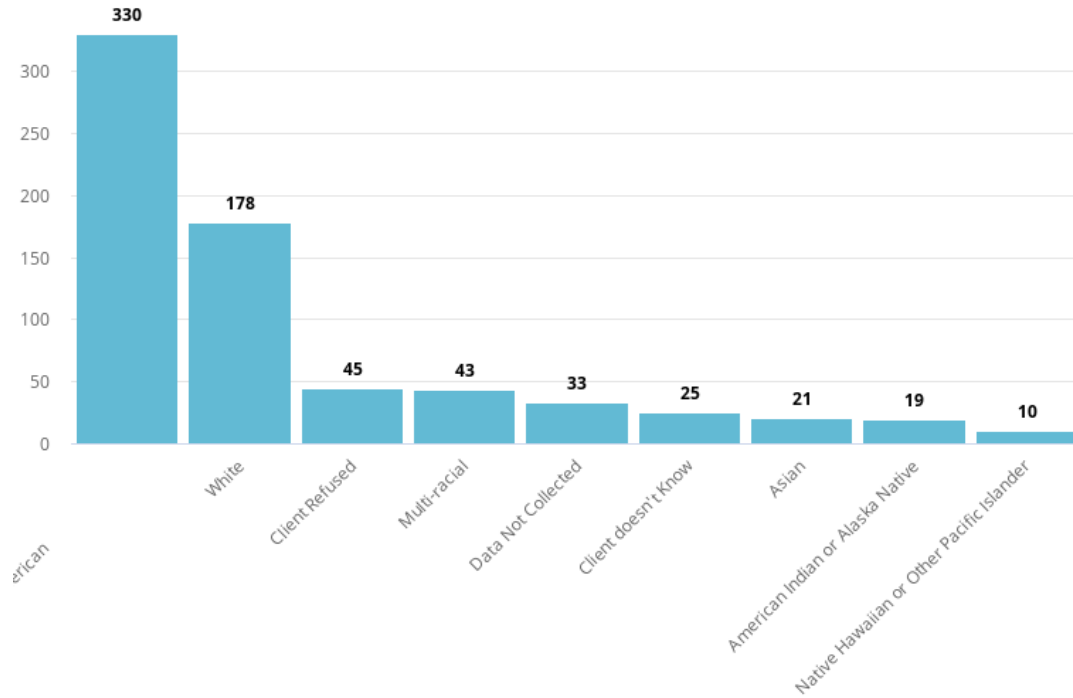

■ General Count ■ Youth Count ■ Shelter Count

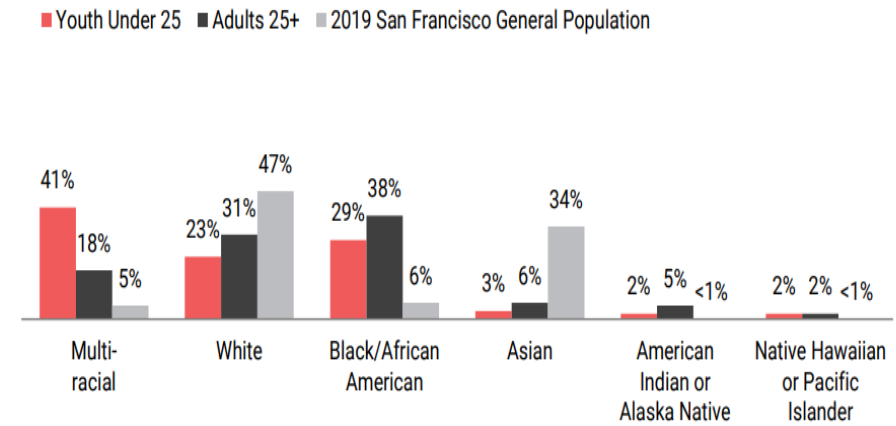

Figure 10. POPULATION BY RACE AND AGE

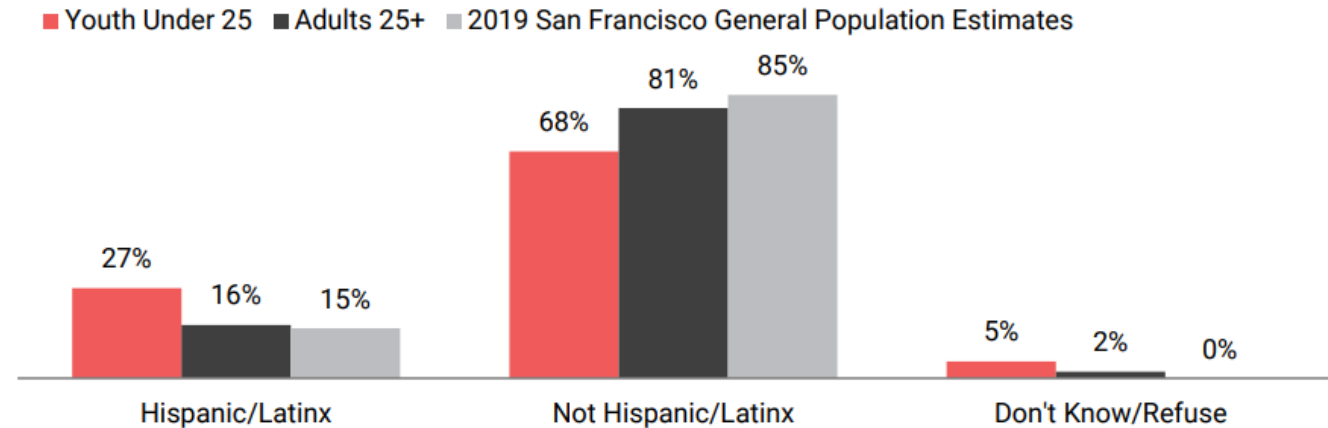
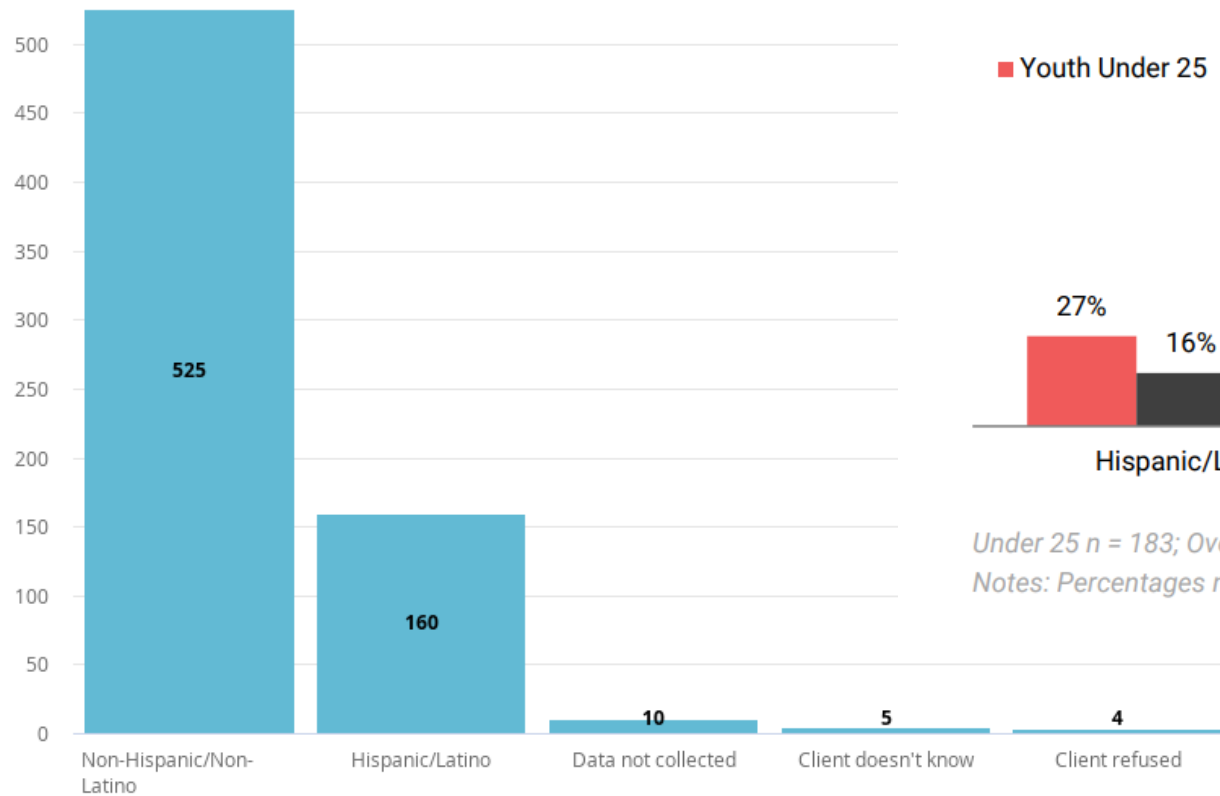

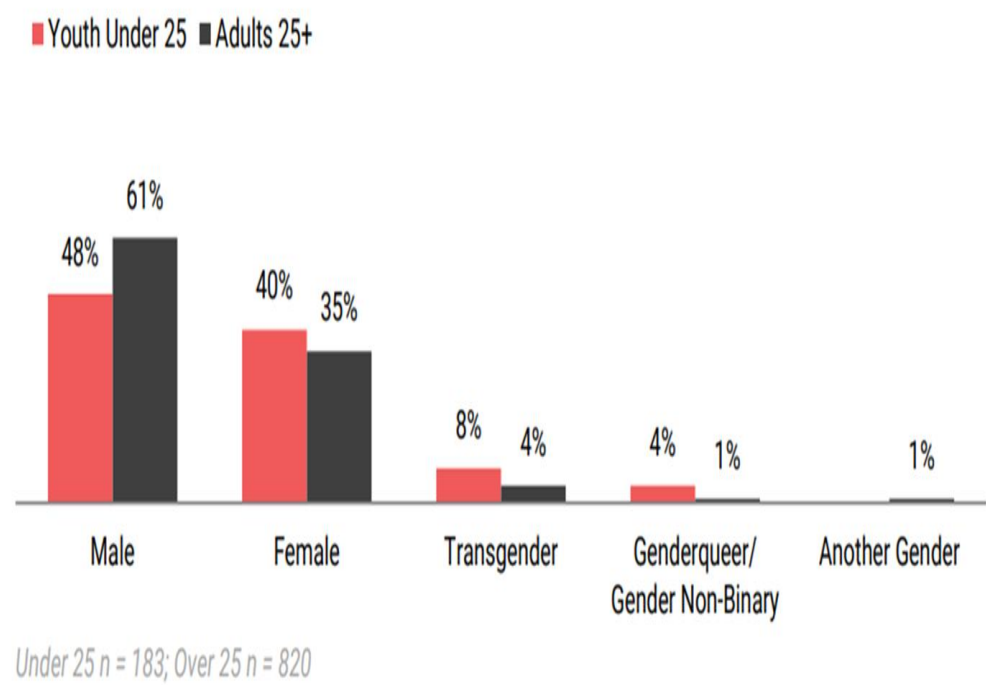
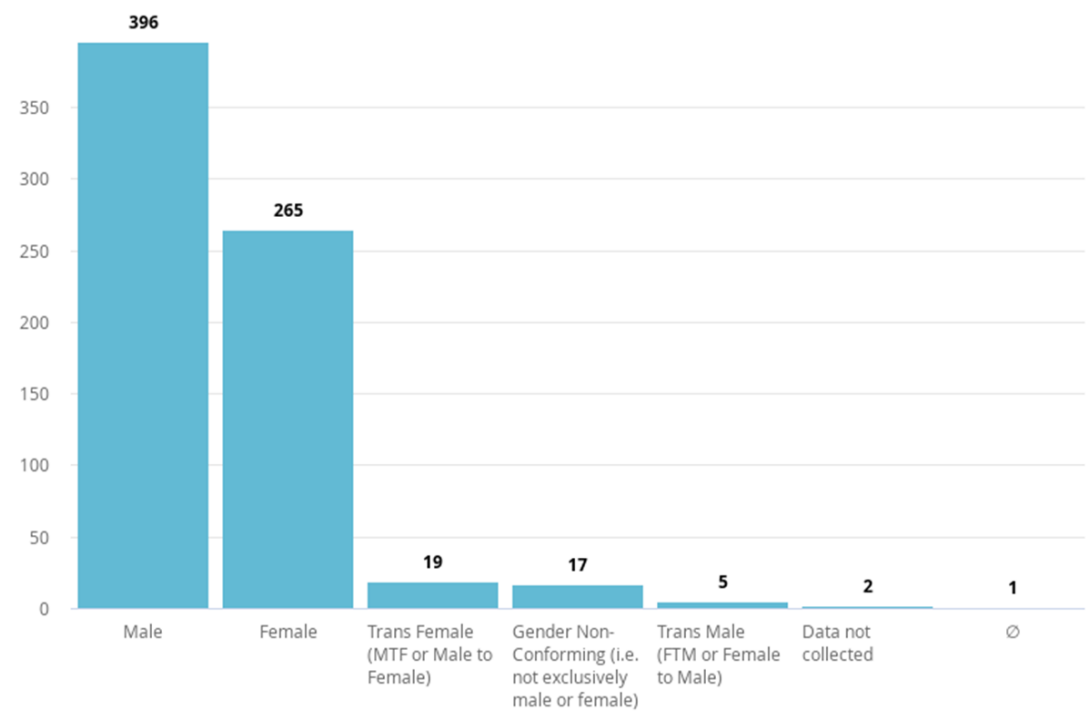

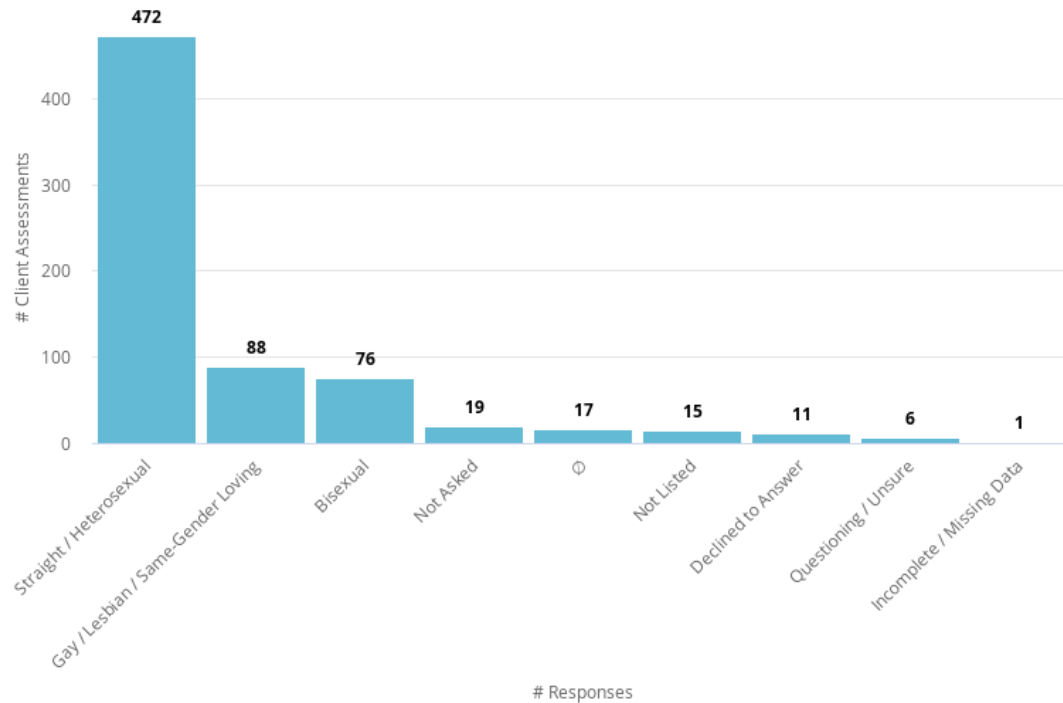
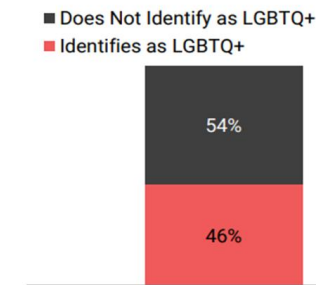


Figure 8. SEXUAL ORIENTATION AND GENDER IDENTITY AMONG LGBTQ+ RESPONDENTS

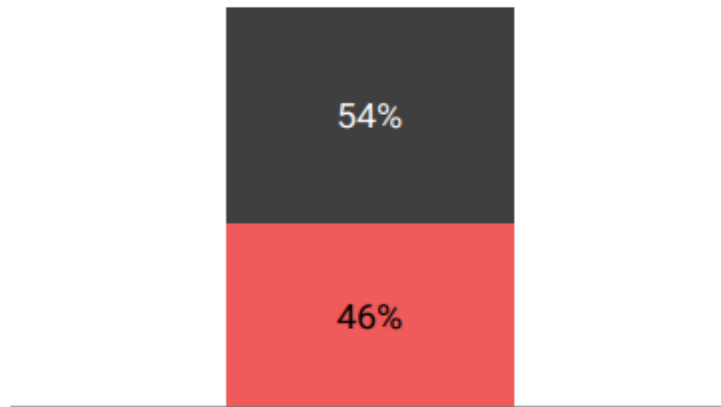
