U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) releases an annual Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)

- Funding competition among approximately 450 Continuums of Care (CoC)
- Last released on August 18, 2021
- Approximately \$2.7 billion available nationally
