Income and Employment Information:

Of the individuals/families who reported employment status (38), 27 were unemployed or underemployed (71%) and 11 were employed (29%)

Of the individuals/families who reported source of income information other than employment (12), 3 people (25%) listed General Assistance, 4 people (33%) listed Supplemental Security Income, 2 people (17%) listed worker's comp, 1 person (8%) listed unemployment, 1 person (8%) listed food stamps, and 1 person (8%) listed "other".
