CoC NOFO Background

U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has released a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)

- Funding competition among approximately 450 Continuums of Care (CoC)
- Released on August 1, 2022, and closed on September 30, 2022
- Approximately \$2.8 billion available nationally

ARD (Annual Renewal Demand)	\$50,153,408
Tier 1 (ARD – YHDP Projects)	\$46,140,241
Tier 2 (ARD – YHDP – Tier 1 + CoC Bonus)	\$4,936,104
CoC Bonus	\$2,507,670
Domestic Violence Bonus	\$1,490,693
CoC Planning	\$1,250,000
YHDP Renewal/Replacement	\$1,584,733

Note on Tiering

Tier 1:

- Conditionally selected from the highest-scoring CoC to the lowest-scoring CoC, provided the project applications pass both eligibility and threshold review.

Tier 2:

- Less likely to be funded. Scored using a 100-point scale based on three factors in a national competition:
 - CoC Score, CoC Project Ranking, Commitment to Housing First
