2022 NOFO to Address Unsheltered Homelessness

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Special NOFO Updates

- 3 projects were submitted as a part of the local competition
 - All projects were submitted by HSH
 - No appeals panel necessary
- Review Panel to convene 10/4/2022
- Special Meeting of LHCB to approve priority list and combined collaborative application 10/18/2022

Rapid Rehousing Project

- Expansion of adult RRH program by 40 Slots
- Includes a parallel application for 70 Stability Vouchers through SFHA
 - This project funds the housing location and support services to compliment the stability vouchers
 - Vouchers require that the CoC has an existing referral partnership Victim Services Organization and a Veteran Services Organization
 - Letter from co-chairs needs to be signed so that SFHA can apply for vouchers
- Will utilize referrals through street outreach, wellness hubs, and collaborations with criminal justice partnerships
 - Allocated through coordinated entry
- Total Funding Requested: \$9,381,488 for 3 years

Supportive Services Only

- Expansion of SFHOT
 - 8 Additional Outreach Workers, 1 Supervisor, 2 Clinical Supervisors, and a team of 4 Peer Support Specialists
 - Peer Support Specialists are a new addition to the model staffed by San Francisco Mental Health Association
 - Helping to Address Hoarding and Cluttering Behaviors
 - Funds for storage services for clients
 - Reframing encampment outreach to focus on housing navigation
- Total Funding Requested: \$6,268,266 over 3 years

CoC Planning Application

- HSH is the only eligible applicant
- Requests funding for an additional staff person to oversee grants awarded through this NOFO.
 - Role will assist with:
 - HUD compliance
 - CoC support
 - Oversight and Administration
- Total Funding Requested: \$223,419 over 3 years
