Dear San Francisco Housing Authority Chief Executive Officer Tonia Lediju,

The San Francisco Continuum of Care (CoC) is committed to partnering with the San Francisco Housing Authority for any Stability Vouchers funded through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)'s 2022 CoC Unsheltered Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO). HSH will develop a prioritization plan with local stakeholders, including existing referral partners, such as Victim Service Providers and Veteran Service Organizations. HSH will refer eligible households to the Stability Voucher program via the city's Coordinated Entry system.

San Francisco 2022 Point-In-Time (PIT) count showed a 15% decrease in unsheltered homelessness since the 2019 PIT count. The Stability Vouchers present an exciting new opportunity for HSH to partner with the San Francisco Housing Authority to continue this recent momentum to end unsheltered homelessness in San Francisco through a community-wide strategy.
