






## **Program Updates: Coordinated Entry**



Urban Alchemy staff at the 711 Post MDT event.


- **► Multi-Disciplinary Team** linking shelter guests to housing and benefits went to 711 Post:
  - 81 guests met with CE.
  - 17 guests became Housing Referral Status.
  - 14 guests had problem solving conversations; 30 additional guests unknown to Coordinated Entry became Problem Solving Status.
  - Upcoming MDTs at 33 Gough and Pier 94 RV site.
- **Safe Housing Community Needs Assessment** report <u>available on the HSH website.</u> Includes 26 recommendations approved by the LHCB.
- ► New referral process started in April for victim service providers to refer into the new rapid re-housing program for survivors of violence (38 households).






Assistance	Amount
Move-in assistance for housing outside the San Francisco HRS, including deposits and first and last month's rent	\$1,660,960
Travel and relocation support outside of San Francisco that will result in a housing connection - airline, train or bus ticket	\$104,445
Rental Assistance after Move-in	\$102,381
Furniture, such as a bed, if reasonable and directly linked to a housing resolution	\$95,998
Contribution to rent or utility costs of another household (non lease agreements) if it will allow the participant to move into the unit or maintain/return to the unit	\$26,272





## **Coordinated Entry & Housing Demographics**











### **Emergency Housing Voucher Rollout**






#### **Move In Locations:**


## **Housing – Placements**






## Housing Vacancies


## **Program Highlights: Housing**

- ← City Gardens started accepting referrals in April.
- → HSH started housing quality inspections in the locally funded PSH portfolio for quality and consistency with CoC sites: pilot with 5 sites this quarter.
- **►** Economic Mobility services expanding to all scattered-site housing programs:
  - 3,500 households eligible for workforce development and financial coaching.
  - Partnerships with Office of Economic & Workforce Dev. and the Office of Financial Empowerment.
- ► Scattered sites team conducting three focus groups with people who live in or have lived in HSH's scattered-site housing:
  - Get feedback on intake, housing search, and case management.
  - Inform development of new policies and procedures.



# HSH Shelter Inventory

- Snapshot as of April 24, 2023.
- Public dashboard available on HSH website; refreshes daily Monday – Friday.
- Ability to filter to drill down on specific programs and populations served.



## **Program Updates: Shelter**

- **Casis Family Shelter** has reopened for 14-day emergency placements and long term stays after a successful lease extension negotiation. ■
- **→Jenning Safe Sleep** to **demobilize** by the end of June 2023.
- **►**Enhanced shelter case management rollout:
  - Trainings every other week for shelter case management staff
  - Sample topics: housing case management approaches; case manager roles and responsibilities, Coordinated Entry 101, Accessing Public Benefits

#### **∽**Hotel vouchers:

- After soft launch in March, Compass Family Services fully opened program for pregnant people and families (called "Urgent Accommodation Vouchers") to referrals from Family Access Points in April.
- Young adults and survivors of domestic violence voucher programs will launch in May 2023 with Saint Vincent De Paul as the provider.

- ► Diversity month: celebrating Arab-American heritage and a multifaith celebration.
- **Coaching circles** continued with support from consultant Equity in Action.

- Continued discussions with providers of color about capacity building.
