- Serve as a key partner to operationalize the redesign workgroup's recommendations
- Develop a charter for the committee
- Meet approximately monthly (and maybe biweekly for the first few months) and dedicate about 4-6 hours each month to the committee on an ongoing basis (ideally 1-2 years)

- Current/past experience of homelessness and/or who have personally utilized the City's CE System or experienced challenges with CE
- Family Coordinated Entry or provision of services for families
- Adult Coordinated Entry or provision of services for adults
- Coordinated Entry for Youth or provision of services for youths
- Safe Housing Working Group / Domestic Violence
- People with current or past experience with the criminal justice system or provision of services for people with involvement with the criminal justice system
