RFP Summary

The intent of this RFP is to invite Proposals from qualified Proposers for the following four Shelter Ancillary Services:

Services	Agreement Type	Reimbursement
Meals for Navigation Centers and Shelters	Grant	The awarded applicant will be reimbursed based on a cost per meal model which includes delivery. Proposers may submit a proposal based on an up to \$7 per meal reimbursement model.
Hot Meals for Alternative Shelter Sites	Grant	The awarded applicant will be reimbursed based on a cost per meal model which includes delivery. Proposers may submit a proposal based on an up to \$8 per meal reimbursement model.
Shelter Transportation	Contract	Proposers may submit proposals with an amount not to exceed \$346,600 annually.
Shelter Client Advocacy	Grant	Proposers may submit proposals with an amount not to exceed \$567,500 annually.

Background

- Meals for Navigation Centers provides meals on demand for guests through working with a meal provider to prepare and deliver frozen meals stored and heated by site staff
- Hot Meals for Alternative Shelter Sites provides two hot meals daily to guests
- Shelter Transportation supports individuals and families experiencing homelessness access transportation to and from shelters and other services in the community
- Shelter Client Advocacy services advocate and act as informal conflict resolvers between shelters and clients
- Home by the Bay: An Equity-Driven Plan to Prevent and End Homelessness in San Francisco 2023-2028 includes expanding HRS by increasing and expanding capacity of shelter services to add additional 1,075 shelter beds

- Provider shall
 - Prepare and deliver approximately 3,326 meals daily
 - Meals should be individually packaged, portioned, packaged, and frozen or able to be stored and reheated by site staff
 - Accommodate special meal requests
 - Provide a menu of meals available

Shelter Transportation

- Provide safe, reliable transportation for homeless adults and families and their possessions on pre-scheduled routes
- Maintain a regular schedule of 10 hours/ day year-round with early morning and late afternoon/ evening schedules
- Provide at least 2 vehicles with licensed and trained drivers that can carry at least 12 passengers and is wheelchair accessible
- Applicants shall propose their dispatch and communication plan when routes need to change and/or if there are staffing issues



Shelter Client Advocacy

- Population served: adults, 18+, TAY, families, older adults and/or veterans experiencing homelessness, marginally housed, and/or at risk of homelessness
- Provide peer advocacy services with a restorative justice lens
 - Monitor the application of Shelter rules
 - Act as informal conflict resolvers between Shelters and clients
 - Provide regular outreach to inform guests of their rights
 - Work in collaboration with shelter providers
