- Action Item: Approve the 2nd amendment to the contract between HSH and Homebase for Continuum of Care Planning and Technical Assistance.

Contract Agreement Overview

- Homebase provides professional services and technical assistance to HSH as the continuum of care administrative entity including oversight of HSH's application to the HUD Notice of Funding Opportunities competition
- Homebase also supports the development of policies and procedures for Coordinated Entry for survivors of violence.
- Services include: project management of the NOFO competition
- Deliverables for the Coordinated Entry for Survivors of Violence include facilitation of the Comparable Database Policies & Procedures workgroup and updates to the HOPE system policy and procedures manual.



Contract Agreement Overview

- Homebase provides professional services and technical assistance to HSH and the San Francisco Continuum of Care (CoC) including oversight of HSH's application to the HUD Notice of Funding Opportunities competition
- Homebase supports the development of policies and procedures for the Continuum of Care, assists HSH with engagement of CoC subrecipients, including analyzing CoC funded activities and community needs.
- Services include: project management of the NOFO competition, technical assistance related to HUD's policy and procedures, and proving ongoing support concerning HUD Compliance of the CoC.
- Deliverables for the Continuum of Care include facilitation of the monthly CoC Subrecipient workgroup and updates to the CoC ESG Desk Guide.
