## Home By the Bay (Strategic Plan Goal)

Goal #1

<u>Decreasing homelessness</u>: Reduce the number of people who are **unsheltered** by 50% an reduce the total number of people experiencing homelessness by 15%.

Goal #2

Reducing Racial Inequities and Other disparities: Demonstrate measurable reductions in racial inequities and other disparities in the experience of homelessness and the outcomes of City programs for preventing and ending homelessness.





## Adult Shelter System



#### **Types of Adult Temporary Shelter Programs**

- **Emergency shelter**: Facilities with amenities and services like showers, food, laundry, security, and case management.
- Navigation Centers: Low-barrier shelter model with amenities and services that offers flexibility for partners, pets, and possessions.
- Cabins: Individual cabin units with communal restrooms, showers, and other amenities and services.
- Trailers: Individual trailers or RVs provided to guests with access to amenities and services.
- Crisis Intervention programs: Spaces where guests can stay safely in their own tent or vehicle and access
  amenities and services.
- Winter Shelter: Time-limited emergency shelter program at rotating locations operating throughout the winter.
- **Shelter Overflow:** Beds and units allocated to guests from congregate shelters who need to temporarily isolate or quarantine due to infectious diseases.
- Emergency Pop-up Shelters: Temporary expansions of shelter for unhoused people during inclement weather, public health emergencies, and other emergency events.
- **Drop-in Centers**: Programs who offer services to people living unsheltered, chairs available for rest.

- Emergency Shelter: Facilities with amenities and services like showers, food, laundry, security, and case management.
- Navigation Center: Low-barrier shelter model with amenities and services that offers flexibility for partners, pets, and possessions.
- Transitional Housing: Facilities that provide people with significant barriers to housing stability with a place to live and intensive social services for up to two years while they work toward ending their homelessness.
- **Urgent Accommodation Vouchers:** Emergency 14-day hotel stays in scattered site SROs that provide roving case management.

# Family Shelter System



### **Types of Family Temporary Shelter Programs**

- Emergency Shelter: Facilities with amenities and services like showers, food, laundry, security, and case management. Most stays are long-term, some are 14-day emergency placements.
- Transitional Housing: Facilities that provide people with significant barriers to housing stability with a place to live and intensive social services for up to two years while they work toward ending their homelessness.
- **Urgent Accommodation Vouchers:** Emergency 14-day hotel stays in scattered site SROs that provide roving case management.
