




Program Updates: Coordinated Entry

•At adult shelters visited by the Multi-disciplinary Team in 2023:

- Reviewed ~1,300 guests' Coordinated Entry status and HSA benefits checks
- 38% reduction in guests unknown to Coordinated Entry
- **15% increase** in Problem Solving Status guests
- 24% increase in guests with a pathway to permanent housing.
- Family rapid re-housing range update.


Project Homeless Connect (December Event): Met with over 150 clients *Success Story:* Youth client was assessed, accepted a housing offer, and applied to the unit within one hour!









Problem Solving Resolutions





Housing Inventory Dashboard











Housing Vacancies

Total inventory: 9,007 units.





Program Updates: Shelter

- Temporary battery power expected by the end of January 2024 at the Bayview Safe Parking program.
- Adult Shelter Reinflation will be completed as of January 1, 2024. This effort has brought online 327 new adult shelter beds across four programs.
- HSH managed shelter waitlist updates as of December 2023:
 - **395 adults** on the Shelter Reservation Waitlist, **48** reservations made in November 2023.
 - 222 families on the individual room family shelter waitlist
 - No specific shelter waitlist for young adults. Young Adults can access TAY-specific shelter through TAY Access Points or access the Adult Shelter Reservation Waitlist.

Program Updates: Family Shelter Placement Reforms (Implemented Dec. 26)

Verification of unsheltered homelessness

Old System: Delays due to required verification

New System: No official verification required.

Referral Timeframe Changes

Old System: 72-hour holds led to unused resources

New System: Same-day referrals reduce offline units

- Streamlined contracting ordinance continued to January.
- New lease for continued use of Bayshore Navigation Center at 125 Bayshore Boulevard
- Accept and Expend for Round 3 Homekey Award for 685 Ellis Street.
- Multiple grant agreement amendments going through the Commission and the Board by end of FY 2023-24
 - Abode Flexible Housing Subsidy Pool Amendment will be introduced on 1/30/2023

2024 Pointin-Time Count

The last full (sheltered & unsheltered) PIT count was conducted February 23, 2022.



January: PIT Count

Street count of unsheltered homelessness is scheduled for Jan. 30. Commission participation encouraged!

Data compiled in subsequent weeks for sheltered count and HIC as of the night of Jan. 30. PIT Survey administered in Feb. 2024.

May: Initial Release

Summary data is reported to HUD; submission deadline TBD.

Key findings are released to media following the HUD submission.

July: Full Report

Full PIT Report, Youth Count Report, and Executive Summaries are published to HSH website.

Includes supplemental data not reportable to HUD and survey findings.



Equity Office Updates

- Ending Trans Homelessness initiative:
 - Affirming Trans Access to Housing training for HSH providers second session on Dec. 8, 2023; monthly sessions through March.
- 3 HSH staff have applied for the **Trauma-informed Systems 2024** cohort:
 - Trauma-informed lens for racial equity work.
 - Develop internal training on these topic areas.
- Strategic planning work under way:
 - Cross-walking Home by the Bay and Racial Equity Action Plan to synthesize external racial equity work into one guiding document.
 - Working with a consultant to apply a targeted racial equity strategy to each component of the homelessness response system.
 - Set baseline and reduction targets to inform equity strategy.
