Coordinated Entry Written Standards

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Update to the Standards adopted by the Local Homeless Coordinating Board in 2018. These updates reflect the developments of the system (ie the launch of the current Adult Access Points and Access Points for Youth). The update also includes the prioritization of the Shelter in Place (SIP) Rehousing Guests.



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The prioritization for all PH, including RRH and PSH is consistent with HUD's Prioritization Notice. Persons eligible for PSH will be prioritized for available units based on the criteria below:

First Priority: Housing Conservatorship Referrals and Certificate of Preference Holders

Second Priority: COVID-19 Emergency Prioritization Shelter in Place Setting (SIP) Rehousing Plan Clients as described in the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing SIP Rehousing and Site Demobilization Proposal

Third Priority: Shared Priority Project – a collaboration between the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing and the Department of Public Health to serve people who are experiencing homelessness who are prioritized by both departments
