The SF Pretrial Diversion Project Access

Point focuses on serving justice involved people who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness. Services include:

- Housing problem solving
- Assessment
- Prioritization
- Referral to housing and other community services



People Experiencing Homelessness while in jail custody can access services provided by this access point:

- Coordinated Entry Enrollment and Assessment
- Coordinated Entry Current living situation assessment for everyone known to Coordinated Entry in jail
- Housing Navigation for people experiencing jail incarceration



Through the Just Home Initiative, SF Pretrial Diversion is also working in partnership with the SF the criminal justice and homelessness response systems to establish and enhance pathways from jail custody to long-term housing that is supportive and stable.



Increased Collaboration is Essential

We are currently mapping out data sources and developing a comprehensive, cross system plan for data collection and access.

The various city departments and agencies involved are also collaborating to create a plan to improve coordination around reentry / discharge planning for people in jail custody.
